Accommodations BOARDING IN A SMALL AND SAFE CITY

Situated in the heart of the 1000 Islands, the city of Brockville, Ontario is designated a 'safe community' by the World Health Organization. Our 108-bed residence, with double gymnasium provides students with a home away from home during their stay. Each floor is Wi-Fi accessible and offers a common room and kitchenette. House System
